- No open fire

NURSERY



- Clean up after use
- No sharp edges exposed
- Safety latches on drawers & cabinets
- Baby monitor
- Window locks

BATHROOM



- Wipe dry after use
- Non-slip mats
- Non-slip pins under rug
- Lid lock for toilet
- Locked medicine cabinet

LIVING ROOM



- Safety plugs on sockets
- Baby proof sharp edges
- Cable ties for chords
- Window locks

CAR



- Car seat
- No phone on back seat
- Working seatbelt
